Dr. Mike Lindsey – State Soil Scientist

A primary member of the soil survey management team and is responsible for maintaining and updating Louisiana soils information via Web Soil Survey and the Field Office Technical Guide; provides soils training and technical soil services leadership for conservation planning activities and to external customers, and serves as the point of contact for NRCS Soil Health Initiative activities.

Chris Coreil – State Agronomist
