The internal control and compliance report contained the following comment:

• Finding No. 12-02: Parish did not follow Bid Laws in obtaining materials for road work. Hauling and tracking costs were not included in the estimates of hot asphalt mix and caused contract to exceed \$150,000 limit set by State Statute for work done on each road.

The Council asks that you review this matter contained in the report for compliance with Louisiana Law and advise me of any actions you have taken or propose to take as a result of the report.
