Dear Mr. Salter:

I am in receipt of the above referenced Proposed Ordinance No. 009-2022. My decision is to veto this proposed ordinance.

After review of the proposed ordinance No. 009-2022, along with Section 1.11 of the Parish of Natchitoches Personnel Manual — Recording Policy, Opinion 22-0001 from the State of Louisiana Attorney General, and the summary concurrence email from Assistant District Attorney, Steven Mansour agreeing with the opinion of the State Attorney General, it is my determination that no change is needed, or required to Section 1.11 of the Parish of Natchitoches Personnel Manual.

The thorough review and opinion of both the Natchitoches Parish Assistant District Attorney, and the Louisiana State Attorney General have determined, and I agree, "The Natchitoches Parish Council may adopt a personnel policy that prohibits parish employees from recording any conversation or activity of another employee, without the consent of the non-recording party [LaAG Opnion 22-001]".

#### PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 009-2022

#### PARISH OF NATCHITOCHES

ADOPTED: April 18, 2022

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 005-2015, more particularly, Section 1.11 of the Parish of Natchitoches Personnel Manual, relative to the Recording Policy.

Section 1.11 of the Parish of Natchitoches Personnel Manual, to remove section 1.11 of removing the recording policy. The Recording Policy reads as follows:

SECTION 1. THE NATCHITOCHES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS, that Section 1.11 of the Parish of Natchitoches Personnel Manual, relative to hereby amended and remove the Recording Policy listed below:

#### SECTION 1.11 – RECORDING POLICY

The Parish is committed to protecting its confidential and proprietary information, maintaining individual privacy, encouraging open communications, and fostering employee morale. Accordingly, no employee shall record (or arrange for another to record), by any audio or visual means, any conversation or activity of another employee or Parish representative without the non-recording party's full knowledge and consent. Exceptions will be allowed only with the express written consent of an employee's supervisor. Violations of this policy may result in disciplinary action, up to and including termination.
