

After further consideration, the court on its own motion does add the following special conditions of bail:

IT IS UPON MOTION OF THIS HONORABLE COURT:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the defendant, shall abide by the below listed conditions of bond, as a condition of release on bond, these conditions being:

1. The defendant shall have absolutely no contact whatsoever with the victim or victims, _____. This no contact order includes no personal contact, **NO THIRD-PARTY CONTACT**, no telephone contact, no email contact, no text messaging contact, no contact via Internet social networking sites (ie: Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.) This defendant will not send messages to the victim, WHETHER IT BE BY FAMILY, ETC.
NO CONTACT MEANS NO CONTACT.
The defendant is ordered to appear before Judge Desiree Duhon Dyess on the _____ day of _____, 2025, for a Firearm Transfer Hearing.
2. The defendant is prohibited from possessing any firearm or weapon while he or she is on bond.
3. The defendant will provide a good service address to the Court for which he or she may be served noticed of his/her court appearances.
4. The defendant will not possess or consume any alcoholic beverages, controlled substances or unauthorized prescription medication while on bond.
5. The defendant will refrain from any and all criminal activities while on bond.
6. APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL: The Court appoints the Public Defender's Office to represent the defendant while he/she is incarcerated. Once the defendant is released from jail, it is his/her responsibility to visit and be interviewed by the Public Defender's Office to determine qualification for continued representation. The Public Defender's Office is located at 710 Third Street, corner St. Denis and Third Street, Natchitoches, Louisiana. THIS APPOINTMENT OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S OFFICE SATISFIES THE APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL REQUIREMENT UNDER LA. CODE CRIM. P. ART. 230.1 (A).
7. The defendant will not operate a motor vehicle while on bond (no driving a car, truck, 4-wheeler, boat, etc.) without a valid driver's license.
8. The defendant is ordered to install the ignition inter-lock device in any vehicle he/she may be driving if driver's license reinstated.

9. OTHER: A must surrender his passport + not leave the country + state of Louisiana without court approval.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant sign the acknowledgment indicating that he or she understands these conditions of release on bond.
