PETITION FOR ACCOUNTING AND FOR REMOVAL OF TRUSTEE

The motion of DARRELL JONES, through his Agent, CHARLES PARKS, (hereafter "Petitioner"), being a person of the full age of majority, domiciled in the state of Louisiana, respectfully represent as follows:

1.

Made defendant herein is:

DAVID WASKOM, Trustee of the George Scott Sluppick Living Trust.

2.

DARRELL JONES was the child of Judith Elaine Sluppick, who was married to George Scott Sluppick. Darrell Jones' finances are handled by his agent, Charles Parks, who brings this suit on behalf of Darrell Jones.

3.

George Scott Sluppick created a Living Trust on February 6, 2007 (hereafter, "the Trust"). David Waskom was named as a successor Trustee and became the successor Trustee upon the death of Judith Elaine Sluppick, upon information and belief.

4.

Judith Elaine Sluppick and George Scott Sluppick owned a home at 1048 Williams Avenue in Natchitoches. At some point, the home at 1048 Williams Avenue in Natchitoches, Louisiana was made part of the Living Trust.

5.

David Waskom, as Trustee, sold the home at 1048 Williams Avenue in Natchitoches for \$450,000.00 on October 30, 2024. On November 25, 2024, David Waskom distributed \$4,230.98 to each of the five (5) beneficiaries named in the Trust. See attached Exhibit "A".

6.

Darrell Jones had paid off the home once his mother, Judith Sluppick, died. The total payoff was over \$200,000.00. The exact amount will be disclosed upon receipt of the canceled check.

7.

Darrell Jones also made interest payments on the home owned by the Trust, paid for repairs and paid bills for the home, all to which he is entitled to reimbursement. The full amount, with receipts, is being gathered and will be supplemented at the direction of this Honorable Court.

8.

David Waskom had indicated to Darrell Jones and his Agent, Charles Parks, that Darrell would be reimbursed for the payoff, bills paid and repairs after closing.

9.

Other than the \$4,230.98 received at the end of 2024, Darrell Jones has not received any other funds from the sale of the home at 1048 Williams Avenue, Natchitoches.

10.

David Waskom became hard to reach and non-responsive to Darrell Jones and/or his Agent, Charles Parks. After six months of trying to get information, Darrell Jones sought the assistance of undersigned counsel.

11.

A demand letter was sent on June 6, 2025 to David Waskom asking for an accounting of the Trust estate. **See attached Exhibit "B"**

12.

Mr. Waskom received the letter on June 9, 2025 and responded on June 16, 2025. Mr. Waskom's response to a demand for accounting was to produce copies of the Trust document, Mr. Sluppick's Will, Living Will and Powers of Attorney, along with a copy of the check stub from the sale of the home in the amount of \$183,282.39 and a spreadsheet showing that Mr. Waskom invested \$162,000.00 of that money on December 10, 2025. **See attached Exhibit "C", in globo.**

13.

A phone call by undersigned counsel to Mr. Waskom's office went un-returned. The intent was to let Mr. Waskom know that the response was insufficient and to discuss the additional information we would like to see and to which Mr. Jones is entitled pursuant to the Louisiana Trust Code.

14.

Though construction services were paid for at or prior to closing on the home, those services were less than \$30,000.00. If the home sold for \$450,000.00 and had been paid off prior to the sale, Darrell Jones, as a beneficiary of the trust, is entitled to see the settlement statement and know where the proceeds were distributed and/or why the proceeds were less than half of the sales price.

15.

Additionally, George Sluppick owned other assets at his death and his Will was a "pour over" Will that left everything to his Trust. As such, the beneficiaries are entitled to an accounting of what assets were collected into the trust and how they were distributed.

16.

Louisiana Trust Code provides that a Trustee who has been derelict in their duties and have not acted in the best interest of the Trust and/or its beneficiaries, can be removed from office after cause is shown.

17.

This Honorable Court has jurisdiction over the matter as Natchitoches Parish is the situs of the Trust.

18.


Petitioner, on information and belief, avers that the said Trustee has mismanaged the Trust, has failed to account for assets and income of the Trust and has improperly disposed of assets of the Trust, all against Louisiana law.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that the defendant be served with this Petition and:

1. That this Court revoke the Appointment of DAVID WASKOM as Trustee;
2. DAVID WASKOM be cast with all costs and attorney's fees;
3. That this Court demand a formal accounting of the assets and income of the Trust; and
4. For such other and further relief as is just and equitable in the premises.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AND AMENDING PETITION

The First Supplemental and Amending Petition for Damages of DARRELL JONES, plaintiff herein, who with respect represents through his agent, CHARLES PARKS, that he does desire to supplement and/or amend his original Petition in the following respects, to-wit:

I.

By amending paragraph 1 of the original petition to add the following defendant:

"1.

...

(2) DAVID WASKOM, as Trustee of the Judith Elaine Sluppick Living Trust.

II.

By adding the following paragraphs:

"19.

The home at Williams Avenue, Natchitoches, was owned in part by the Judith Elaine Sluppick Living Trust, of which defendant, David Waskom, is trustee.

20.

Defendant took an exorbitant fee of \$20,000.00 from the proceeds due to the Judith Elaine Sluppick Living Trust from the sale of the home without an itemization or disclosing such to plaintiff.

21.

Defendant paid off loans at closing of which plaintiff was unaware, as plaintiff used his funds to pay off the home, thus there should not have been any loans to pay off.

22.

Defendant allegedly invested a majority of the proceeds due to the Judith Elaine Sluppick Living Trust, totaling \$156,680.00, but has not provided plaintiff with an accounting of where those funds were invested, earnings on that investment or any relevant information to those funds.

23.

The new allegations herein are related to the allegations in the original petition and should be heard at the same time and in the same Rule to Show Cause to be reset by motion filed this same date."

III.


Plaintiff re-alleges and re-urges all of his allegations in the original Petition as if written herein in extenso.




